Dear Parents/ Carers of Secondary aged pupils

Home Testing

You secondary aged child will come home with a box of testing kits - there are seven in a box.

You use two each week - Sunday night/ Monday morning an hour before school or Thursday evening/ Friday morning an hour before school.

Your child knows how to swab (10 seconds each nostril, insert about an inch, blow your nose first!)

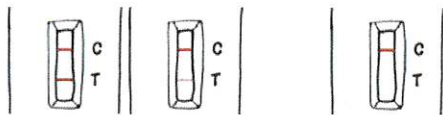
Place into dropper with the fluid (break top of fluid and put in)
Swirl it around for 15 seconds and squeeze the tip of the dropper.
Press the cap onto the tube.

Add 2 drops to the S part of the specimen well (the white plastic part that looks like a pregnancy test!)

Time for 30 minutes and then read - have a look below and read the booklet with your kit.

You must wait 30 minutes - one line next to C is NEGATIVE

Two lines next to T and C is POSITIVE. You need to let us know and report to the NHS (www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result).



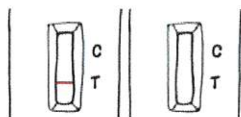
Positive result:
Any visible coloured line on "C" and "T", which may be faint

Negative result:
Coloured line on "C" only

Hopefully they will know what to do but if you get stuck please call us or 119 for the testing helpline.

When you have finished put into the small plastic bag and put in normal rubbish.

Invalid or void result:
No coloured line on "C"
