Thank you for filling out the referral form, it is important to us to work in partnership with you and families. The choice to enrol a child into the Intervention Class is dependent on consent from the Parents/Carers and can be cancelled by them at any time.

The Intervention Class will be over two days depending on year group and attainment levels: generally Years Two and Three attend Thursdays and Fridays, Years Four, Five and Six attend on Mondays and Tuesdays. We do not accept two children at the same time from the same school on the same days.

The Brookfield School will provide you with feedback throughout the child's time with us and will keep in contact with you to arrange review meetings, usually by email. The Aim of our Intervention Class is to help and support children to thrive and remain in their mainstream school.

All transport needs are to be provided and paid for by the host school. The host school will also be responsible for payment of a child referred to the intervention class this cost starts at £60.00 per day and increases after a term of intervention.
